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Online Test Generator Features

2025 Updates

1. Support for Bi-Language Tests (Jun-2025)

Users can now add question text in multiple languages and create a Bi-Language Question Paper in which the primary language questions are shown on one side and the secondary language questions are shown on the other side of the question paper.

2024 Updates

2. Support to create test using existing tests / merge tests (Dec-2024)

Individual subject teachers can create tests of their own subjects and admin can then create a new test using the existing tests created by teachers. This is useful for creating multi-subject tests like for JEEMains, NEET, etc.

3. AI Integration for Question Bank (Aug-2024)

User can now use our integrated AI engine to check for compliance of the questions in the question bank. Users can also use AI to generate NEW questions, review them and add them to their question bank – thereby allowing them to create a question bank VERY easily with quality questions.

4. Support for Internal Choice Questions while editing Test Questions (Aug-2024)

This feature is particularly useful for those who are generating CBSE pattern tests. CBSE pattern has internal choice in some of the questions. An online test created on LearnMagica can now easily be edited to provide internal choice on any of the questions. The paper output looks exactly like CBSE papers.

5. Question Move/Copy Feature is now supported at Topic level. (Aug-2024)

This feature is useful for institutes who are maintaining their own question banks on LearnMagica. Questions are often the same for multiple exams – like MHTCET and JEEMains. Institutes need not re-enter in the respective boards. They can use the Move/Copy feature to manage the Question Bank.



2024 Updates

6. Import Curriculum – Board, Class, Subject, Chapter, Topic (July-2024) (

This feature is very helpful for institute who are creating their own question bank on LearnMagica for the first time. Instead of manual entry, user can now import the curriculum details from an easy to edit excel file – just fill in the details of board, class, subject, chapters, topics in an excel file and import it in one shot.

7. Created By field in Question Entry (July-2024)

Each Question is now tagged with the user who created the question.

While creating a test (CYOT), teachers can search for the questions which they have added/imported – this helps them create papers from their own questions.

Admin can also search for Questions added or imported by a particular teacher.

8. Export Test Answer Keys in Excel (July-2024)

Now answer keys can be exported into pdf as well as excel file (as per user's convenience and need)

9. Resize Images in Question Editor for faster data entry (July-2024)

10. Import test – maintain question import sequence (July-2024)

When user creates a test using Import Test, the same sequence of the questions is maintained as given by user in import file – in export test and online test rendering.

2023 Updates

11. Speech to Text Support in Question Entry (May-2023)

This feature makes data entry very easy and fast. Simply read out the text that you want to enter – and it gets converted to text.

12. OCR Support (Convert image to Text) in Question Entry (May-2023)

This feature also helps in data entry – all text from an image is converted to text which can be easily edited. If you want to enter questions from a text book, you need not type the text – you can just click a picture, select it in OCR to convert the image to text.

13. Export Test to PDF Format (Jan-2023)

This is helpful for conducting offline tests. Users can create a question paper in LearnMagica and export it to PDF for printing. (with Institute header including Institute Name, logo, Test Name, Test Duration, Max marks, Watermark)

14. Set Question Number Continuity (Jan-2023)

User can set whether they want the question numbers to be reset at Test level, subject level or section level. Question numbers are shown according to the setting in Test Preview, Test Rendering and Test Export.

15. Set Answer Options Display preference (alphabetic or numeric) (Jan-2023)

User can set whether they want the answer options to be alphabetic (a, b, c, d) or numeric (1, 2, 3, 4). This is done to support JEE Mains and NEET Tests (as conducted by NTA).

2022 Updates

16. Question Count Summary Report (Dec-2022)

This report is a very handy tool to get a quick view into the count of the question bank at chapter level or topic level, difficulty level wise count, question type wise count, mark wise count and so on. The report can also be exported into excel.

17. Utility for checking Duplicate Questions in the databank (Nov-2022)

Users can now check for duplicate questions while adding new questions manually or using import questions. User can also check for duplicate questions in their existing databank. Support is also added for checking duplicate answer options within a question.



2022 Updates

18. Support for Topic Wise Test Creation (Nov-2022)

Now users can create tests at Topic Level. Chapters are further bifurcated into topics and questions can be added at Topic Level. This is useful if you want to create a test from selected topics instead of choosing questions from the whole chapter.

19. Support for New Test Type – Create Your Own Test (CYOT) (Aug-2022)

If teachers want to hand pick questions for a test, then they can do it using CYOT – the list of questions is shown based on the curriculum criteria selected, and questions can be included in the test by simply ticking on the checkbox next to the question.
